## Level 1 Workshop

is designed to provide you with:

- ◆ the ability to articulate the paradoxical and complex needs of twice exceptional students
- ◆ an awareness of how the learning environment and teaching style impact/influence the success of the twice exceptional student
- ◆ a review of the basics of RtI for use in twice exceptional identification and programming
- ◆ the ability to define and utilize strength-based programming within an RtI framework in the development of an educational plan for a twice exceptional students
- ◆ the skills necessary to identify evidence-based strategies for twice exceptional students
- ◆ suggestions for working with twice exceptional parents
- ◆ the opportunity to collaborate with others in order to develop an educational plan that is responsive to the student's profile
- ◆ examples of written learning plans (e.g. ALP, IEP, 504)

## Level 2 Workshop

is designed to provide you with:

- ◆ an awareness of how the learning environment and teaching style impact/influence the success of the twice exceptional student
- ◆ practice in the use of a Response to Intervention (RtI) problem-solving model to analyze data from a variety of sources to identify:
  - student strengths
  - student needs
  - potential interventions
  - delivery options for twice exceptional students
- ◆ strategies and resources to address both strengths and challenges of twice exceptional students
- ◆ the opportunity to collaborate with your school team in order to develop an educational plan that is responsive to your own case study
- ◆ an opportunity to collaborate with your school team to develop written learning plans (e.g. ALP, IEP, 504)
- ◆ the opportunity to discuss various twice exceptional programming options in districts (large, small, urban, rural)

Participants are expected to have a basic understanding of the characteristics of twice-exceptional learners and their unique needs and/or have attended Level 1 Training.
